Two license agreements are presented below.

1. HCL Trial and Demonstration Agreement
2. HCL Master License Agreement

If Licensee is obtaining the Program for the purpose of evaluation, testing, trial "try or buy," or demonstration (collectively, an "Evaluation"):

By clicking on the "Accept" button below, Licensee accepts both (i) the HCL Trial and Demonstration Agreement (the "Evaluation License"), without modification; and (ii) the HCL Master License Agreement (the "MLA"), without modification.

The Evaluation License will apply solely during the term of Licensee's Evaluation.
