

## LICENSE INFORMATION

Program Name: HCL Connections v7.0

The following standard terms apply to Licensee's use of the Program.

### Limited use right

The Program may also be referenced as the "Principal Program" herein. This right is limited to the level of Authorized Use, such as a Processor Value Unit ("PVU"), a Resource Value Unit ("RVU"), a Value Unit ("VU"), or other specified level of use, paid for by Licensee as evidenced in the Proof of Entitlement. Licensee's use may also be limited to a specified machine, or only as a Supporting Program, or subject to other restrictions. ### Terms for Oracle Outside In Technology

#### Processor Value Unit (PVU)

Processor Value Unit (PVU) is a unit of measure by which the Program can be licensed. The number of PVU entitlements required is based on the processor technology and the number of processors made available to the Program.

Licensee can deploy the Program using either:
